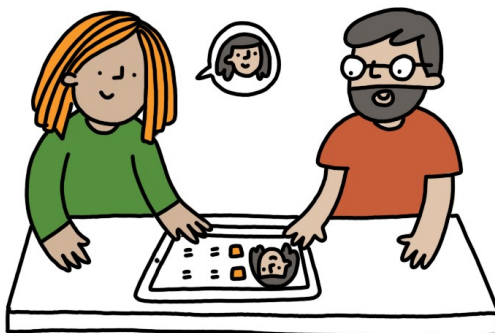
## LEARN FROM OTHER TEACHERS

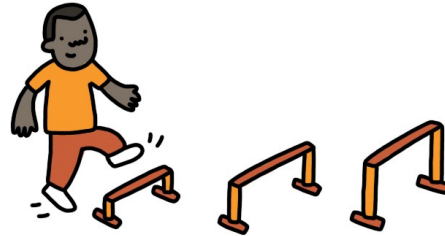
## ASK YOUR STUDENTS

Why not ask your students for feedback? What works well and what would they like to do next?



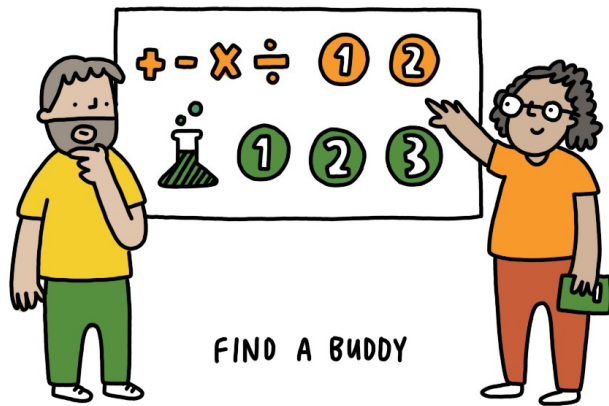
## REACH OUT TO PARENTS
